Mayor Kelly Leighton called the meeting to order at 6:57 PM at Colome City Hall. Council members present were Duffy, Hill, and Nelsen. Council member Heese attended via teleconference. Council members Dougherty and Kutz were absent. Also present were Finance Officer Harter, Utility Manager Harter, and visitor Kurtis Atteberry. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance

Agenda- Motion to Approve: Motion by Hill, second by Duffy, to approve the agenda as written. Motion carried 4-0

PURPOSE OF MEETING- 2nd Readings of Ordinance 2025-3 and Ordinance 2025-4, 1st Readings of Ordinance 2025-5, Ordinance 2025-6, and City Drainage

Old Business- *Second reading for passage and approval of Ordinance No 2025-3 "An Ordinance providing for collection and disposal of garbage,"*- Motion by Heese, seconded by Nelsen, to approve the second reading for passage and adoption of Ordinance No. 2025-3, An Ordinance Providing for the Collection and Disposal of Garbage. Roll call vote: Duffy – aye, Heese – aye, Hill – aye, Nelsen – aye. Motion carried unanimously, 4-0.

Second reading for passage and approval of Ordinance No 2025-4 "An Ordinance regulation open burning,"- Motion by Duffy, seconded by Hill, to approve the second reading for passage and adoption of Ordinance No. 2025-4, An Ordinance Regulating Open Burning. Roll call vote: Duffy – aye, Heese – aye, Hill – aye, Nelsen – aye. Motion carried unanimously, 4-0.

New Business- *First reading of Ordinance No 2025-5 "An Ordinance for house sewers"* Motion by Hill, seconded by Heese, to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 2025-5, which increases the rates to \$30.00 per month. All ayes. Motion carried unanimously, 4-0.

First reading of Ordinance No 2025-6 "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of the Water System and Prescribing Rates and Charges for Water Service and the Collection" Motion by Hill, seconded by Duffy, to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 2025-6, which increases the utility rates to \$21.00 per month for in-town residents and \$26.00 per month for outlots. All ayes. Motion carried unanimously, 4-0

City Drainage- Alley between 2nd and 3rd street A discussion was held regarding city drainage. A motion was made by Duffy and seconded by Nelsen to continue the discussion at the May 6th meeting. All ayes motion carried 4-0.
